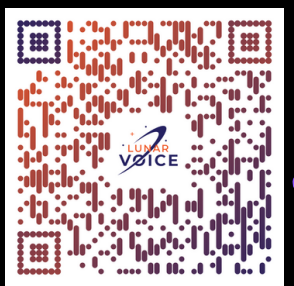

- **Create a Safe Space:** Set up a quiet, comfortable area where your dog can retreat if the doorbell, costumes, or commotion overwhelms them. This could be a room with their favourite bed, toys, and some calming music.
