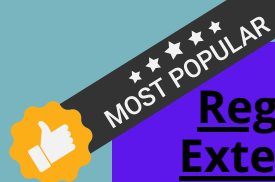

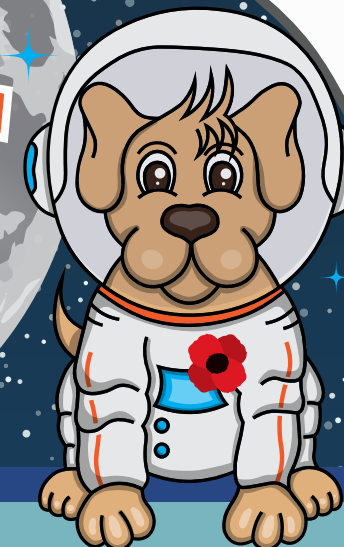

Tips for Safe and Fun Snow Play with Your Dog

1) Protect Paws: Snow, ice, and salt can irritate your dog's paws. Consider using paw wax or booties to prevent cracking and discomfort, and check paws regularly for ice buildup.

2) Set Limits: Even the most enthusiastic snow-lover should avoid extended time in frigid temperatures. Monitor for signs of frostbite (especially on ears and tail) and head inside for a cozy warm-up after play.

5) Stay Warm: Not all dogs are built for cold weather. Smaller breeds and those with thin coats might need a doggy jacket. Be mindful of signs your pup is too cold, like shivering or lifting paws off the ground.

4) Visibility is Key: Winter days are shorter and sometimes darker. A reflective collar or LED leash makes your dog easy to spot, whether you're walking them or letting them play around.

3) Hydrate: Cold weather can be dehydrating, so keep fresh water available even when it's chilly outside. Avoid letting dogs eat too much snow, as it can sometimes upset their stomach.
